FLPD SERVES SEARCH WARRANTS

On March 8, 2011, at approximately 4:00 P.M., the Fort Lauderdale Police Department served two residential search warrants in an effort to combat narcotic sales in the community. The search warrants targeted two residences, 842 Northwest 1st Avenue and 804 Northwest 4th Avenue, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Detectives were made aware of these two specific residences through community outreach and several nuisance complaints in the area.

Combined, Fort Lauderdale Police Detectives recovered approximately a half ounce of crack cocaine, one .45 caliber handgun, one stolen A.T.V., multiple fraudulent identity sets, and approximately \$600.00 in U.S. currency.

Also, three suspects were successfully taken into custody without further incident and charged with several felony counts. The suspects' identities are being withheld pending further criminal investigation.

This two pronged assault on narcotic sales in the City of Fort Lauderdale demonstrates the Police Department's commitment to enhance the quality of life for all residents and serve the members of the community.
