HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on March 19, 2011, at approximately 4:55 P.M. The homicide took place at 1305 Northwest 4th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Initially, Fort Lauderdale Police Officers responded to a call in reference to a disturbance at 1305 Northwest 4th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Upon arrival, officers located Michael Goodlow, B/M, 6/30/67, a Fort Lauderdale resident, lying on the ground after suffering multiple stab wounds to his torso. Goodlow was trauma alerted by Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue to Broward General Medical Center, where he was pronounced deceased after succumbing to the stab wounds.

Investigators learned that Goodlow got into a verbal altercation with Herman Dean, B/M, 11/5/52, who is the resident of 1305 Northwest 4th Street. The altercation escalated and became physical. At one point during the physical altercation, Dean armed himself with a knife and stabbed Goodlow multiple times.

Dean was still on scene when police arrived. Dean was placed under arrest and charged with 2nd Degree Murder. The investigation is still active and on going.
