## CHILD PORNOGRAPHY ARREST

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department, in conjunction with the South Florida Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, executed a search warrant on June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011. The search warrant was for an apartment located at 1124 Northeast 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

While conducting an undercover investigation, an ICAC Detective from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department located an IP address that was sharing child pornography. The investigation revealed that the IP address was located at 1124 Northeast 5 Avenue #5, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The warrant yielded over thirty graphic videos of children being sexually abused by adults. These videos were located on the suspect's computer and storage discs. Many of the children depicted in these videos ranged from 1-4 years of age.

Joseph F. Miller, W/M, 10/4/47, was arrested and charged with thirty (30) counts of Possession of Child Pornography. Miller was also charged with narcotics violations.
