HOMICIDE

UPDATE (9/28/2011):

Detectives from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department have identified the victim of the homicide as Stanley "Toucan" Apollon, B/M, 5/6/87, a Fort Lauderdale resident.

The circumstances behind the shooting are still under investigation and detectives are actively pursuing all leads in the case.

Based upon preliminary witness statements, the suspect has been described as a black male, possibly in his mid twenties, medium build, wearing all red clothing, with shoulder length dreadlocks.

ORIGINAL (9/20/2011):

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a shooting that occurred on September 19th, 2011, at approximately 9:50 P.M. The shooting took place in the 1100 block of Northeast 16th Court in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

On September 19th, 2011, Fort Lauderdale Police Officers were notified of a shooting in the 1100 block of Northeast 16th Court. The officers arriving on scene were advised that friends had already transported the victim to Broward General

Medical Center, prior to police being notified. The victim was later pronounced deceased at the hospital.

The unidentified victim is a black male, possibly in his late 20s.

Detectives are diligently investigating the circumstances behind the shooting, as well as the identity of the suspect.
