## **BURGLAR SEEKS EASY PREY**

October 11, 2011

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is reminding the public to remove property from plain sight and secure their vehicles before leaving them unattended.

During the early morning hours of Sunday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011, Fort Lauderdale Police Officers observed a male rummaging through a parked vehicle in the 1200 block of Northeast 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Once contact was made with the subject, Fort Lauderdale Police Officers were able to determine the man was in fact burglarizing the vehicle.

Officers on scene diligently canvassed the area and located four other vehicles nearby, all of which had also been burglarized. All of the victims to these vehicle burglaries were identified, contacted, and desired to prosecute. The suspect was then taken into custody.

The suspect has been identified as Kyle Sullivan, W/M, 04/22/1983, a Pembroke Pines resident with an extensive criminal history. Detectives believe that Sullivan targeted the aforementioned vehicles because they were unsecured. Sullivan has been charged with five counts of Burglary of an Unoccupied Conveyance.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department's Intelligence Led Policing Unit worked collectively with the State Attorney's Office to present these charges to Judge Hurley at Sullivan's First Appearance Hearing. Due to Sullivan's criminal history, his recent conviction and the information detailed in this arrest, his bond was increased and set at \$12,500.
