MISSING ENDANGERED ADULT

UPDATE 12/1/11:

On December 1st, 2011, the Fort Lauderdale Police Department was called by staff members from the Fort Lauderdale Retirement Home, advising that Stevenson had been returned to their care.

Officers responded to the retirement home and confirmed that Stevenson was in good health and had safely returned home.

Officers learned that Stevenson had been visiting his friends during the time he was believed to be missing.

ORIGINAL 11/30/11:

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is searching for a missing endangered adult male who was last seen on November 29th, 2011, at approximately 7:00 A.M. The male was reported missing to the Fort Lauderdale Police Department on November 29th, 2011, at approximately 6:35 P.M. The male was last seen leaving on foot from the Fort Lauderdale Retirement Home located at 401 Southeast 12th Court in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The missing adult has been identified as Eddie Stevenson, B/M, 6/16/46, 6' 0" in height, weighing approximately 180 pounds and has short grey hair. Stevenson was last seen wearing a red shirt, beige pants, and dark sunglasses.

Stevenson is considered legally blind, although he does not carry a cane, and was last seen leaving the retirement home to go for a walk by himself at approximately 7:00 A.M. on November 29th, 2011. According to the staff at the Fort Lauderdale Retirement Home, this is the first time Stevenson has left the residence and not returned.

Investigators are urging anyone with information regarding the whereabouts of Eddie Stevenson to immediately contact the Fort Lauderdale Police Department at 954-828-5700 or their respective local Law Enforcement Agency.
