HOMICIDE

February 11, 2012

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on February 11th, 2012, sometime before 6:00 A.M.

On February 11th, 2012, at approximately 6:00 A.M., Fort Lauderdale Police Officers responded to the call of a vehicle crashing into a fence in the 1800 block of Northeast 15th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale. When they arrived, they located a male who had sustained serious injuries. The injuries were not consistent solely with that of a car crash.

The victim was immediately transported to Broward General Medical Center by Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue where he was later pronounced deceased.

The victim has been identified as Tobias Kelly, B/M, 35 years of age, a Sunrise resident.

Detectives believe that Kelly was possibly attacked at another location and crashed his vehicle into the fence as a result of his injuries. The types of injuries, as well as the cause of death, are still under investigation.

This is still a very active investigation and detectives are pursuing all leads.
