FATAL TRAIN VERSUS PEDESTRIAN CRASH

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a traffic fatality where a train struck a pedestrian. The incident occurred on March 16th, 2012, at approximately 4:00 A.M. The collision occurred on the railroad tracks just south of the railroad crossing at Southwest 2nd Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that a 19 year old white male was lying near the railroad tracks when a northbound train struck him. The male was pronounced deceased on scene. Detectives believe the male to be a resident of Cooper City, Florida, but are awaiting a confirmed identification from the Broward County Medical Examiner's Office.

This is still an active case and the events leading up to the collision are under investigation.
