## **Traffic Crash Fatality**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a traffic fatality that occurred on March 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012, at approximately 1:25 P.M. The traffic fatality occurred in the 600 block of Southeast 4<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that Rosa Rivera Kim, W/F, 09/21/1977, a Plantation resident, was driving westbound on Southeast 4<sup>th</sup> Street, where for unknown reasons, she lost control of her vehicle. As a result, she struck the south side curb, over the sidewalk and into the Riverside Hotel Poolside Cabana.

At the time of this crash the poolside cabana was occupied by Alanna Demella, W/F, 05/27/1985, a Medford, Massachusetts resident and her husband, Michael Demella, W/M, 03/27/1980. Alanna and her unborn child were pronounced deceased on scene. Michael was transported to Broward General Medical Center for minor injuries and later released.

Kim sustained non-life threatening injuries and was transported to Broward General Medical Center, where she is listed in stable condition.

Kim was driving a 2006 silver Audi 4-door sedan.

This investigation is active and ongoing. Investigators are still determining if charges will be filed.
