**SHOOTING**

On May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012, at approximately 7:40 P.M., the Fort Lauderdale Police Department received a call regarding a male who had been shot and was waiting for Fire Rescue at 666 West Broward Boulevard in the Burger King parking lot.

As Officers arrived on scene, they located the victim, Jordan L. Mosby, B/M, 7/27/92, a Fort Lauderdale resident, in the back seat of a vehicle. Mosby had sustained a gun shot wound and was immediately transported to Broward General Medical Center by Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue, where he is currently listed in critical condition.

Detectives do not believe that Mosby was shot at the Burger King and are seeking any information that would detail Mosby's whereabouts leading up to the shooting.
