DOUBLE SHOOTING

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a double shooting that detectives believe occurred in the 1400 block of Northwest 1st Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The shooting occurred at approximately 8:30 P.M. on Monday, May 14th, 2012.

Fort Lauderdale Police Officers responded to the Dunkin Donuts, located at 1450 West Broward Boulevard, at approximately 8:30 P.M., regarding a male being shot in the leg. As officers arrived on scene, they located Jonathan Carter, B/M, 2/14/92, a Fort Lauderdale resident, who had sustained a gunshot wound to the leg. At the same time, responding officers observed a black vehicle speeding away, westbound from the Dunkin Donuts, and stopped the vehicle in the 1700 block of West Broward Boulevard. Inside of the vehicle, Officers located the second victim, Wayne McCoy, B/M, 4/1/89, a Fort Lauderdale resident, who had been shot in the abdomen. Both Carter and McCoy were transported to Broward General Medical Center and are currently listed in stable condition.

Witness statements and physical evidence confirmed that the shooting occurred in the 1400 block of Northwest 1st Street. Detectives believe that after the shooting occurred, Carter fled on foot to the Dunkin Donuts and McCoy ran back to the vehicle without realizing he had been shot.

Detectives are investigating the circumstances behind the shooting. Anyone with information regarding the shooter or motive is urged to come forward.
