**FLPD CAPTURES ONE OF
AMERICA'S MOST WANTED**

On June 8th, 2012, members of the Fort Lauderdale Police Fugitive Unit received information from the New Jersey State Police that a fugitive was possibly transient in the City of Fort Lauderdale. New Jersey State Police identified the fugitive as Robert Marone, W/M, 69 y.o.a, and was one of the top 12 most wanted fugitives out of New Jersey.

Acting upon information received from the tip, detectives from the Fort Lauderdale Police Fugitive Unit, which consists of Fort Lauderdale detectives assigned to the F.B.I. Fugitive Task Force and U.S. Marshall Service, immediately conducted a follow up investigation and started pursuing leads. Fort Lauderdale Police Fugitive Detective Chuck Morrow, along with the Fort Lauderdale Career Criminal Unit, were able to locate Marone within a matter of hours. Marone was located in the 1000 block of State Road 84 in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Marone was wanted in New Jersey for parole violations stemming from a 1971 murder conviction as well as a warrant for Aggravated Sexual Assault on a Child in 1992. Marone's warrants were issued in July of 1992 for the Aggravated Sexual Assault on a Child as well as the Parole Violation for Murder. Marone had been on the run for nearly 20 years and was featured on America's Most Wanted back in March of 2002.

Marone was taken into custody by Fort Lauderdale Police Detectives without further incident and is currently being held at the Broward County Main Jail, awaiting extradition back to the State of New Jersey.
