## BURGLARY TRIO CAUGHT ON SURVEILLANCE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department's Burglary Unit is currently investigating a residential burglary that occurred in broad daylight, at approximately 8:45 A.M., on May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2012. The brazen trio of burglars chose a residence located at 2518 Arbor Drive, in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Unbeknownst to this trio, the residence is equipped with a home security surveillance system.

The surveillance footage shows one of the three suspects approaching the front door of the residence, and knocking to see if anyone is home. When there was no answer, this suspect and two additional suspects walk around the front of the residence and enter the gate of a wooden privacy fence. The suspects walked through the backyard of the residence to the victim's vessel. The suspects removed the prop from the motor of the vessel and left the area.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department has been receiving many complaints of similar burglaries, where the suspects are stealing marine equipment from vessels throughout the city. The Fort Lauderdale Police Department's Burglary Unit is actively investigating these incidents.
