HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on July 12th, 2012, at approximately 7:30 P.M. The homicide took place in the 500 block of Northeast 11th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

On July 12th, 2012, Fort Lauderdale Police Officers responded to a call regarding shots being fired in the 500 block of Northeast 11th Street. As officers arrived on scene, they located a deceased male in the middle of the street.

Immediately, a perimeter was established and apprehension K-9 officers were summoned to the scene. Officers also utilized the assistance of the Broward Sheriff's Office Aviation Unit to conduct a search of the area. The suspect(s) had fled the immediate area prior to police arrival.

The victim has been identified as Lawrence Conaway Jr., B/M, 9/13/84, a Fort Lauderdale resident.

Based upon a preliminary investigation, Fort Lauderdale Homicide Detectives believe that Conaway was walking in the area when two unknown black male subjects approached him. Some sort of confrontation ensued, and Conaway was shot to death. Detectives are working on possible suspect information as well as a motive behind the homicide.
