HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that was discovered on September 11th, 2012, in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The homicide occurred in a residential complex located at 625 Antioch Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

At approximately 9:50 A.M., on September 11th, 2012, the Fort Lauderdale Police Department received a call in reference to a male, named "Alberto", who possibly murdered his wife. The initial address provided did not exist in the City and officers were tasked with locating the complex based on the reportee's physical description of the building.

When Fort Lauderdale Police Officers arrived on-scene a W/M exited the apartment with self-inflicted, superficial cuts on both of his arms. The male identified himself as "Alberto" and was detained. The officers feared for the safety of anyone inside the apartment and immediately entered the residence to render aid. Officers discovered a lifeless W/F inside the residence.

The victim has been identified as Danitza Gomez-Reyes, W/F, 06/28/76, a Fort Lauderdale resident.

The suspect has been identified as Alberto Ramos, W/M, 12/09/62, a Fort Lauderdale resident.

Detectives discovered several knives inside the apartment that Ramos used on himself sometime prior to his surrender.

This is an active and on-going homicide investigation. Investigators are urging anyone with information regarding this homicide, to contact Detective Jim Jagers at 954-828-5970.
