MOTORCYCLE THEFTS

Surveillance Footage Available for Pick-Up

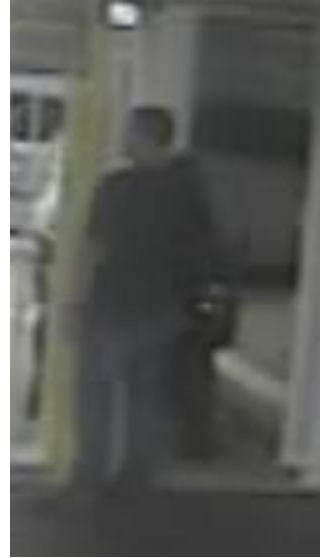
The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating two motorcycle thefts that occurred during the early morning hours of Wednesday, November 14, 2012 at the Berkley South Condominium in the City of Fort Lauderdale. The Berkley South Condominium is located at 3015 North Ocean Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Based upon surveillance footage, detectives have learned that, at approximately 4:10 A.M., two high-end motorcycles were stolen from the condominium's parking garage.

The surveillance video shows the suspects arriving in an unknown silver 4-door sedan. A single suspect exits the vehicle and walks up to a newly installed keypad on the security gate to the parking garage. Detectives believe the suspect presses the button requesting security to open the gate to the garage. When the garage gate begins to open, the suspect walks back to the silver vehicle and drives into the garage.

The silver vehicle then drives back to the garage gate and appears to use the same method that he used to gain access, in order to exit the garage. Two additional suspects are then seen riding the stolen motorcycles out of the parking garage directly past the surveillance cameras.
