Assistant Chief: Anthony C. Williams

Anthony C. Williams has served the Fort Lauderdale Police Department since January of 1993. Anthony has served the department in the Operations Bureau as a Patrol Officer, Patrol Supervisor, Shift Captain, Executive Officer and a District Commander. Anthony has also served the department in the Criminal Investigations Division, the Community Policing Unit and the Staff Inspections Office as the Department's Accreditation Manager. Anthony is a veteran of the US Army and holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice from Lynn University and a Master of Science Degree in Emergency Planning Administration.
