HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on April 22, 2013 at approximately 8:13 P.M. The homicide occurred at 1000 Southeast 4th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Fort Lauderdale Police Officers responded to a call of a domestic disturbance between a father and son. Upon arrival, they discovered neighbors subduing a male suspect, while a severely injured elderly male lay nearby.

The victim was identified as Norman Scott, W/M, 10/17/31, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Scott received multiple stab wounds throughout his torso and was transported to Broward Medical Center. Scott succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Homicide Detectives took the victim's son into custody and charged him with one (1) count of First Degree Murder. The suspect has been identified as Douglas Scott, W/M, 01/15/62, a Fort Lauderdale resident.
