In light of the tragic terrorist attack in Boston members of The Fort Lauderdale Police Department have volunteered to financially aid the victims from the Boston bombing incident.

Employees that worked The Lauderdale Air Show 2013 were afforded the opportunity to donate a \$1.00 for every hour they worked the event. Those members who did not work the event have also made contributions. The total amount of collected funds was \$4,000. A check will be mailed via The Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge 31 to The One Fund Boston (www.onefundboston.org).

The One Fund Boston is a foundation formed by Massachusetts Governor Deval Patrick and Boston Mayor Thomas Menino. This fund was created to raise money to help those families most affected by the tragic events that unfolded during Monday's Boston Marathon.
