The Fort Lauderdale Police and Fire Departments, in partnership with the Greater Fort Lauderdale Convention & Visitors Bureau, are proud to host the 2013 Florida Police and Fire Games. This is the first time that the City of Fort Lauderdale will play host and only the second time in 20 years that the week-long multi sports event will be played in South Florida.
