The Fort Lauderdale Police Department responded to an Armed Robbery that occurred on Monday, May 27th at approximately 5:05 P.M. The incident occurred in the parking lot to the rear of 320 Southwest 2nd Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Two suspects entered the parking lot armed with a knife and demanded the valet attendant to turn over his wallet. At some point, a physical altercation ensued between the suspects and the victim. As a result, the victim was stabbed and the suspects fled the area.

A witness walking in the area saw the valet attendant profusely bleeding and called 911. The victim was transported to Broward Health Medical Center.

The victim has been identified as Luis Alberto Valdez, W/M, 04/26/60, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The suspects were last seen running south from the parking lot.

The first suspect is described as a B/M, in his 20's, 5'7" to 5'10" in height, thin build, wearing a white t-shirt, black shorts, and possibly carrying a dark backpack.

The second suspect is described as a B/M, in his 20's, 5'10" to 6'01" in height, thin build, wearing a black t-shirt, and black athletic shorts.
