Assistant Chief: Raul Diaz

Raul Diaz has served the Fort Lauderdale Police Department since November of 1989. Raul served in the Patrol Division as a Patrol Officer, Patrol Supervisor and Shift Captain. He also served in the Special Investigations Division and Operation Support Division as the Division Commander and the Executive Officer to the Chief of Operations. Additionally, Raul served the Department as a SWAT Team member, Explosive Detection K-9 handler and Bomb Squad Commander.
