CHILD PORNOGRAPHY ARREST

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department received a call from a distraught man who was threatening to harm himself. The man informed the 911-call-taker that he was having suicidal thoughts as a result of his child pornography collection.

Fort Lauderdale Police Officers and a Detective assigned to the South Florida Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force responded to 489 West Melrose Circle in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The male caller was identified as Cameron M. Seymour, B/M, 10/27/1993. Seymour made contact with the officers on scene and gave a sworn taped statement to detectives. Seymour admitted to searching for and downloading approximately (500) five hundred images of child pornography onto his laptop computer.

A preliminary examination of the defendant's cell phone yielded (12) twelve videos of children engaged in sexual acts. Many of the children captured in these videos appeared to be as young as (2) two years old and as old as (12) twelve years old.

Further charges are pending the outcome of a full forensic examination of his computer.

Seymour was arrested and charged with (12) twelve counts of Possession of Child Pornography and (1) one count of Use of Computer to Obtain Child Pornography.
