HOME INVASION ROBBERY

UPDATE 02.06.14:

Violent Crimes Detectives received tips after the release of this video and have identified one of the suspects responsible for this home invasion robbery. That suspect has been identified as Junior Cime, B/M, 9/12/84, a resident of the City of Delray Beach.

At approximately 9:00 A.M. on January 21st, detectives from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department Violent Crimes and Career Criminal Unit, in conjunction with the U.S. Marshals Florida Caribbean Regional Fugitive Task Force and Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, located Cime at the Palm Beach County Courthouse.

Cime has been charged with the following;

- (2) Counts of Robbery with a Firearm
- (1) Count of Burglary of Occupied Dwelling with a Battery

ORIGINAL 12.23.13:

Detectives from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department are investigating a home invasion robbery that occurred today at approximately 6:45 A.M. The home invasion occurred at 607 Southwest 6th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Investigators have learned that while the male and female residents were sleeping, two disguised suspects forced entry into their residence. The suspects disguised themselves with black ski masks and restrained the victims inside one of the rooms. The suspects then rummaged through the house stealing an undisclosed amount of property and the female victim's vehicle.

The stolen vehicle is a 2012 white Lexus IS250 sedan, bearing Florida license plate BLMV77. It should be noted that there is a Kansas State Alumni metal frame around the license plate.

After the suspects fled the scene, the victims were able to run to a neighbor's house to call the police.
