HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred on January 1, 2014 at approximately 11:36 P.M. The homicide occurred at 1708 Northwest 16th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Fort Lauderdale Police Officers responded to a call of someone who was attacked. Upon arrival, they discovered a male victim lying on the side of the residence with multiple stab wounds.

The victim was identified as Norman Cameron, B/M, 5/3/72, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale. Cameron was pronounced deceased at the scene.

A perimeter was established and Fort Lauderdale Police K-9 Officers responded to the scene. K-9 Officers tracked the suspect to a neighboring residence located at 1709 Northwest 15th Place. The suspect was attempting to conceal himself in the bushes at that residence.

The suspect has been identified as Scott Lloyd, B/M, 11/28/57, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Lloyd was taken into custody and charged with the following;

- (1) Count of Murder
- (1) Count of Resisting Arrest Without Violence

Detectives have since learned that Lloyd and his estranged girlfriend have been involved in an on-going domestic dispute.

Earlier in the day, Lloyd arrived at his estranged girlfriend's residence armed with a knife. Lloyd smashed the windshield of her vehicle and used the knife to flatten all four of the tires, before he fled the scene.

Lloyd then made several phone calls to his estranged girlfriend, threatening her with physical violence before returning back to her residence later that evening.

After Detectives exhausted all efforts to locate the knife used to commit this murder, they requested the assistance of Fire Medic Julie Padelford-Jansen, from the City of Miami Fire Department. Padelford-Jansen is a member of the FEMA Urban Search and Rescue of Florida Task Force. She and her Human Remains Detection K-9 partner, "Riot", responded and located the murder weapon, which was buried at the scene.
