## COUNTYWIDE BURGLAR ARRESTED FOR MULTIPLE RESIDENTIAL BURGLARIES

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department responded to a residential burglary that occurred on January 19<sup>th</sup> at approximately 2:45 P.M. The burglary occurred at 2733 Northeast 21<sup>st</sup> Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The victim arrived home to find a masked suspect fleeing from her residence. The victim called 9-1-1 and provided descriptions of both the suspect and the suspect's vehicle.

A Fort Lauderdale Police Officer responding to the area located the vehicle and took the suspect into custody.

The suspect has been identified as John Moss, B/M, 1/10/98, a City of Fort Lauderdale resident.

Property Crimes Detectives interviewed Moss and he provided them with information for a total of eight (8) residential burglaries that he committed within the county.

The burglaries occurred at;

- 2733 Northeast 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale
- 2832 Northeast 26<sup>th</sup> Street, Fort Lauderdale
- 401 Carolina Avenue, Fort Lauderdale
- 433 Farmington Drive, Plantation
- 6361 Southwest 1<sup>st</sup> Court, Plantation
- 321 South Fig Tree Lane, Plantation

Detectives are reviewing the details Moss provided for two other burglaries, which were also committed in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Moss is being charged with one count of Burglary of an Unoccupied Dwelling and one count of Possession of Burglary Tools.

This remains an active investigation with further charges pending.
