MISSING ENDANGERED MALE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is requesting assistance from the public in locating a missing endangered male.

Howard Ward was last seen on January 26, 2014 at approximately 11:00 A.M., when he was released from the Broward County Main Jail located at 555 Southeast 1st Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Ward's caretaker expected Ward to contact him when he was released, and he has not seen or heard from him

Law enforcement officials conducted a canvass of the area, checked local hospitals and homeless shelters, and have not been able to locate him.

Ward is described as a W/M, 5'6", 140 lbs., long wavy brown hair, blue eyes, and a thin build. Investigators were not provided with a possible clothing description.

Investigators were told that he requires medication for Paranoid Schizophrenia and he has been without medication during this time.
