**SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT
LEAVES MAN
CRITICALLY INJURED**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a suspicious incident that occurred on Thursday, March 6th at approximately 1:38 A.M. The incident occurred in the area of Vramar Street and North Atlantic Boulevard.

A witness, who was walking along North Atlantic Boulevard, observed an unknown white male either being pushed out or jumping out of a moving vehicle. The witness was so startled by the observation that he was unable to gather a description of the vehicle. As the witness ran to render aid to the injured male, the vehicle continued to travel southbound on North Atlantic Boulevard.

The male has been identified as Daniel Flynn, W/M, 12/23/84, a resident of the City of Saugus, Massachusetts. Flynn was transported to Broward Health Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries and remains in critical condition.

Due to Flynn's current condition and the lack of surveillance footage, detectives are asking for the public's assistance with this active and on-going investigation.
