MISSING ELDERLY MALE

Hodge has been located in good health and reunited with his family.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is requesting assistance from the public to locate a missing elderly male.

James Athlebert Hodge was last seen this afternoon at approximately 1:00 P.M., when he drove his wife to the Broward County Governmental Center located at 115 South Andrews Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Hodge dropped his wife off at the entrance to the building and told her he would park the car and then meet her inside. Hodge's wife advised investigators that she has not seen or heard from him since.

Law enforcement officials conducted a canvass of the downtown area and the area surrounding his residence in the City of Pembroke Pines, and have not been able to locate him or his vehicle.

Hodge is described as an eighty-two year old, B/M, 5'10", 180 lbs., bald, brown eyes, with an average build. Hodge was last seen wearing a brown shirt, brown pants and brown shoes. Hodge does not have any known mental or physical conditions and is not known to wonder or stray from his family.

Hodge's vehicle is described as a 2010 silver Jeep Patriot, bearing Florida license plate T101WH.
