GRAND LARCENY: THE NEW SHOOTERS WATERFRONT

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a grand larceny that occurred in broad daylight at approximately 9:00 A.M. on Friday, August 15th. The incident occurred at the New Shooters Waterfront restaurant located at 3033 Northeast 32nd Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Two unknown male suspects entered the parking lot of the business and dismantled twenty-five (25) individual decorative light fixtures. The light fixtures were located around the perimeter of the parking lot. Once the suspects dismantled and cut the wires to each light, they placed them into black trash bags and fled from the business with over \$5,000 worth of stolen property.

This area of the business was equipped with security surveillance and the cameras captured the suspects committing the above offense, and then walking outside the view of the cameras.
