CLICK IT OR TICKET

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is participating in the Department of Transportation's "Click it or Ticket Challenge." This Enforcement Phase runs from November 17th to November 30th.

The "Click it or Ticket Challenge" was created to inform the public of the dangers associated with not wearing a seatbelt while operating a motor vehicle.

In 2013, the National Center for Statistics and Analysis recorded a seat belt use rate of 87.2% for the State of Florida (http://www-nrd.nhtsa.dot.gov/Pubs/812030.pdf). The public is reminded that seat belts help save lives, and too often occupants of vehicles forget about the impact a seatbelt can make in their own safety.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department urges the public to keep themselves and their vehicle's occupants safe, and "*click it*."
