ARMED ROBBERY: PAPA JOHN'S PIZZA

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating an armed robbery that occurred on Wednesday, October 29th at approximately 12:40 A.M. The incident occurred at the Papa John's Pizza located at 4700 North Federal Highway in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

As the employees were closing the store, two armed and disguised suspects forced the employees back into the store demanding them to open the safe. Both victims feared for their lives and complied with the suspects' demands.

While the suspects were waiting for the employees to open the safe, they disabled the surveillance equipment at the business. Once the safe was open, the suspects were given an undisclosed amount of U.S. currency and then fled from the business.

The first suspect is described as a B/M, approximately 20-29 years of age, approximately 5'8" in height, medium build, wearing all black clothing and armed with an unknown handgun.

The second suspect is described as a B/M, approximately 20-29 years of age, approximately 5'8" in height, medium build, wearing all black clothing and armed with an unknown handgun.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department Violent Crimes Unit will be sharing information with neighboring agencies to determine if they have experienced similar incidents.
