ARMED ROBBERY

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating an Armed Robbery that occurred on Sunday, November 30th at approximately 1:44 A.M. The incident occurred at the Exon Mobil Gas Station located at 1300 Northeast 4th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The suspect entered the business posing as a customer. When the suspect approached the counter, he brandished a small handgun and pointed it directly at the clerk. The armed suspect demanded the U.S. currency from the register and several packs of cigarettes. The clerk, in fear for his life, complied with the suspect's demands and placed the U.S. currency and cigarettes into his backpack.

The suspect is being described as a dark skinned black male, thin build, with short twists in his hair.
