TRAFFIC HOMICIDE
HIT AND RUN

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a traffic homicide hit and run that occurred on Saturday, December 27th at approximately 8:00 P.M. The crash occurred in the 1400 block of Northwest 19th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Investigators have learned that while a 2003 blue Ford F-150 was traveling eastbound in the right lane of Northwest 19th Street, a pedestrian was crossing the street from north to south. As the pedestrian walked into the right lane, the vehicle struck the pedestrian projecting him onto the south side sidewalk. The motorist failed to render aid or report the incident and fled from the scene.

The pedestrian, who was pronounced deceased at the scene, has been identified as Hurley McCrimmon, B/M, 10/27/59, a resident of the City of Lauderhill.

Investigators later located the suspect's vehicle in the City of Lauderhill.

This is an active and on-going investigation.
