## **FATAL SHOOTING**

### **Update: 04.17.15**

Fort Lauderdale Homicide Detectives have identified the suspects responsible for the fatal shooting of victim Lakendra Jones.

These two suspects have been identified as Harveitz Beaubrun, B/M, 10/01/95, a City of Tamarac resident and Martelli Metellus, B/M, 07/26/90, a City of North Lauderdale resident.

Detectives from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department Homicide Unit and Career Criminal Unit, in conjunction with the FBI Violent Crimes Fugitive Task Force located Beaubrun and Metellus in the City of Riviera Beach.

Beaubrun and Metellus were arrested at approximately 7:00 P.M. on April 11, 2015 with the assistance of Riviera Beach Police Department in the City of Riviera Beach.

Beaubrun has been charged with the following:

- One Count of Murder

Metellus has been charged with the following:

- One Count of Accessory After the Fact of 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder

### **Original: 02.02.15**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a fatal shooting that occurred on Sunday, February 1<sup>st</sup> at approximately 7:30 P.M.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department received a report of a female victim who was unconscious and heavily bleeding. When officers responded to 741 Northwest 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, they discovered a female lying outside with a fatal gunshot wound.

Officers administered CPR to the victim until Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue arrived on scene and transported her to Broward Health Medical Center. The victim later succumbed to her injuries and was pronounced deceased at the hospital.

The victim has been identified as Lakendra Jones, B/F, 6/18/96, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

This is an active and on-going investigation. Detectives are gathering details surrounding this fatal shooting and attempting to determine the location where the incident took place.
