CHILD PORNOGRAPHY ARREST

On July 9th at approximately 7:00 AM, Fort Lauderdale Police Department detectives, in conjunction with the South Florida Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, executed a search warrant at a private residence located at 814 Northeast 14th Place, Apartment 3, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

With the assistance of software developed by the non-profit organization Child Rescue Coalition, ICAC detectives of the Fort Lauderdale Police Department located an IP address actively trading child pornography. Further investigation identified the physical address associated with this IP address as 814 Northeast 14th Place, Apartment 3, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Upon executing the search warrant, Fort Lauderdale Police Department detectives along with members of the ICAC task force from the Broward Sheriff's Office and Federal Bureau of Investigation, located and seized a computer containing over (10) ten graphic videos of children as young as (4) four years old being sexually abused by adults.

The defendant in this investigation has been identified as Jorge E. Vasquez 3/1/1983, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Vasquez was taken into custody and charged with the following:

- (10) Ten Counts of Possession of Child Pornography
- (1) One Count of Use of Computer to Compile Child Pornography; and,
- (1) One Count of Possession of Child Pornography with Intent to Promote
