Update (2): 08.18.15

Fort Lauderdale Police Department investigators are continuing their investigation in the suspicious disappearance of Mackrell from a Valero gas station located in the City of Pompano Beach. Additional video footage from the gas station indicates that Mackrell was involved in what appears to be a dispute with the occupants of another vehicle. The unknown black male, pictured below, was a passenger in this vehicle.

Investigators would like to identify this individual and speak with them in regards to assisting with any details that may lead to Mackrell's whereabouts.

Investigators have learned that on July 30th at 2:32 A.M. Mackrell made a purchase at the Valero gas station located at 3601 North Dixie Highway in the City of Pompano Beach.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is requesting assistance from the public in locating a missing male.

Steven James Mackrell was last seen on July 30th at approximately 1:30 A.M. in the 600 block of West Las Olas Boulevard after leaving the downtown area in the 200 block of Southwest 2nd Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Mackrell is described as a 25 year old, W/M, 5'10", 150 lbs., and medium build. He was driving a white four door 2013 Ford Fusion, bearing Florida License Plate WJ70L.

Detectives have learned that Mackrell entered his vehicle, which was parked in the 600 block of West Las Olas Boulevard. He drove westbound on West Las Olas and then turned right, North, on Northwest 7th Avenue. Law enforcement officials conducted a canvass of the downtown area along with the Fort Lauderdale Nautical Unit conducting a canvass of the waterways and have not been able to locate him or his vehicle.

Mackrell's family is asking the public for any information on where he may have gone.
