## MISSING ENDANGERED MALE

## **UPDATE: 1.26.16**

Detectives have learned that Mr. Brown has safely returned to his residence. Brown returned to his home in good health.

## **ORIGINAL: 1.15.16**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is requesting assistance from the public in locating a missing endangered adult male.

Stephen Brown was last seen on Tuesday, January 12<sup>th</sup> at his residence in the 1400 Block of Northwest 20<sup>th</sup> Street, in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Since that time, Brown has not been seen or heard from by caretakers.

Brown is as a 72 year old, W/M, 6 feet in height, and approximately 145 lbs. He has a slim build with brown eyes and grey hair. He was last seen wearing a blue jacket, blue shirt, and blue denim jeans.

Brown – who is considered endangered – suffers from high blood pressure, hearing loss, and COPD. He takes psychotropic medications and has a history of seizures.

Brown is known to frequent areas in the City of Oakland Park and the City of Wilton Manors.
