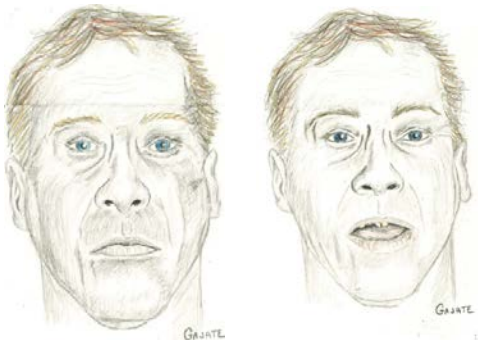
**PUBLIC ASSISTANCE  
NEEDED TO IDENTIFY  
DECEASED MALE**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is seeking the assistance of the public in identifying a deceased male that was recovered on August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at approximately 7am. The deceased male was located in the 1900 Block of NW 9<sup>th</sup> Avenue, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The deceased white male is believed to have been approximately 45 to 55 years old. He is described as being 5 feet 5 inches in height and 135 pounds; with blue eyes and blonde, graying hair. The male has a scar several inches in length on his back and is missing several teeth. He was found wearing a dark red long sleeve shirt and khaki colored pants with red, white, and blue shoes.

Foul play is not suspect to have played a role in this incident; however investigators have not yet successfully identified this individual and are seeking the community's assistance.
