BUSINESS BURGLARY AT TOYS-R-US (Video Available)

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a burglary that occurred at Toys-R-Us located at 1600 North Federal Highway on Friday, November 28, 2008, at approximately 1:00 A.M. Fort Lauderdale Police Officers were responding to the business as a result of an audible alarm when it was found opened.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the suspects entered through the rear receiving door and smashed the display cases and went into the electronic stock room and began to remove merchandise. The loss of this burglary includes IPods, PSP game systems, video games, GPS's and cameras.

The surveillance video shows at least four male suspects. Three of the suspects were wearing black hoodies and the fourth was wearing a white hoody. All of the suspects were wearing what appeared to be white gloves.
