HOMICIDE

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating a homicide that occurred at approximately 8:28 P.M. on December 16, 2008 in the 1500 block of Northwest 8th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that a subject walked up to the area and started shooting into the crowd. As a result of this, the suspect struck three adult males. All three victims were transported to Broward General Medical Center for their injuries. Jason Exantus, 6/24/1981, a Fort Lauderdale resident, succumbed to his injuries. The second victim John D. Overland, 5/13/1990, a Fort Lauderdale resident is listed in stable condition at Broward General Medical Center. The third victim Herod Vedrine, 2/26/1986, a Fort Lauderdale resident was treated and released.

The suspect was described as a black male, 5'10", 180 pounds, wearing all black clothing with a mask and gloves. The culprit was last seen fleeing westbound towards Northwest 9th Avenue.
