TORTUGA MUSIC FESTIVAL ADVISORY

The Tortuga Music Festival will be held at the Fort Lauderdale Beach Park, 1100 Seabreeze Boulevard Friday, April 7th through Sunday, April 9th. The event is scheduled on Friday, April 7th from 1:00 P.M. to 10:00 P.M. The event is scheduled from 11:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M. on both Saturday, April 8th and Sunday, April 9th.

Organizers anticipate a daily crowd attendance upwards of 30,000 for the event. The event features top country and rock artists, marine conservation exhibits and culinary delights. A portion of the beach is designated for the music festival and will be reserved for ticket holders.

Traffic Advisory:

Motorists are advised that a high volume of traffic and delays may be expected on all barrier island roadways, especially A1A and Seabreeze Boulevard. Delays may also be expected on Southeast 17th Street Causeway and Las Olas Boulevard.

The only partial road closure for this event is SE 5th Street (between the Aquatic Complex and SR A1A). The southern side of the parking area will be closed during the event to accommodate shuttle bus traffic.
