TRAFFIC ADVISORY: COLOR RUN

The Color Run Dream Tour returns to the streets of Fort Lauderdale on Saturday, April 29th. Motorists are encouraged to carefully review the listed road closures and should expect traffic delays from 6:00 A.M. until approximately 12:00 P.M.

The race is tentatively scheduled to begin at 7:30 A.M. Race organizers are expecting approximately 4,000 runners and walkers to participate in this year's event.

Street Closures and Detours: (http://thecolorrun.com/ft-lauderdale/)

- Saturday, April 29th
 - 3:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M.: East Las Olas Boulevard will be closed from Andrews Avenue to Southeast 3rd Avenue. Las Olas River House traffic will be allowed intermittent access when needed.
 - 7:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M.: There will be rolling closures along the following roadways and intersections:
 - Southeast 1st Avenue will be closed from Southeast 2nd Street to Huizenga Plaza.
 - > Southeast 2nd Street between Southeast 1st Avenue and Southwest 9th Avenue.
 - Southwest 9th Avenue between Southwest 2nd Street and West Las Olas Boulevard.
 - West Las Olas Boulevard between Southwest 9th Avenue and Southwest 7th Avenue.
 - Southwest 7th Avenue adjacent to Cooley's Landing Park.
 - Southwest 7th Avenue Bridge.
 - Southwest 4th Avenue between the 7th Avenue Bridge and Southwest 7th Street.
 - Southwest and Southeast 7th Street between Southwest 4th Avenue and
 - Southwest and Southeast 7⁻⁵ Street between Southwest 4⁻⁷ Avenue and Southeast 3rd Avenue.
 Southeast 3rd Avenue between Southeast 7th Street and Southeast 4th Street (including the Southeast 3rd Avenue Bridge).
 Southeast 4th Street between Southeast 3rd Avenue and Southeast 5th
 - Avenue.
 - New River Drive between Southeast 5th Street and Southeast 1st Avenue.
 - 12:00 P.M.: Projected time that all listed detours and closures will be reopened and returned to normal operations.

Event organizers have placed electronic message boards throughout the route to inform motorists of the above closures.
