FLPD SEEKS ASSISTANCE WITH HIT AND RUN INVESTIGATION

Fort Lauderdale Traffic Homicide Investigators have updated the vehicle description in reference to this hit and run incident. The updated information is for a white 2004 to 2008 Acura TSX sedan. Once again, the vehicle may have considerable front, passenger side damage.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is seeking assistance from the public in locating the driver and vehicle involved in a hit and run collision which resulted in a pedestrian being hospitalized with injury. The incident occurred on Monday, April 8th around 4:30 am; near the intersection of West Broward Boulevard and Northwest 7th Avenue in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that a white sedan, possibly a 2004 to 2006 Honda Accord was driving westbound in the 700 Block of West Broward Boulevard. The vehicle collided with the pedestrian as he walked westbound along the north side of the roadway. The driver of the vehicle failed to stop and render aid for the injured pedestrian, and fled the area. The vehicle may have considerable front, passenger side damage.

The pedestrian was transported to Broward Health Medical Center with injury.
