ELDERLY WOMAN MISSING

<u>Update:</u>

Ann Bouie returned home this morning at approximately 2:40 A.M. Bouie was in good condition and appeared well.

Original:

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is requesting help from the public in locating a missing elderly woman, who has been diagnosed with Pre Alzheimer's.

Ann Whitfield Bouie, B/F, was last seen on Monday, November 24, 2008, at approximately 12:30 P.M. Bouie was last seen at 4830 Northeast 26 Street, Fort Lauderdale, FL. A doctor last saw Bouie at that location.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that Bouie called a friend from the doctor's office and told that friend that she was en-route to their home. Bouie never arrived at the friend's home.

Bouie, a Fort Lauderdale resident, was born on August 1, 1929. She is described as being 5'3", 150 pounds, and her hair is gray and black. Bouie was last seen wearing a white shirt with black and white pants. She was driving a 2003 Toyota Corolla, four door vehicle, and blue in color. The tag to the vehicle is Y1QPW.
