**SUSPECT ARRESTED AFTER
ATTEMPTING TO RUN
VICTIM OVER WITH
VEHICLE**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating an aggravated assault that occurred on Sunday, July 9th at approximately 1:12 P.M. The incident took place at 2309 Northwest 20th Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the victim and suspect were involved in a verbal altercation about the victim's new significant other. The altercation turned violent when the suspect attempted to intentionally hit the victim with her vehicle. The victim was able to avoid being struck, at which point the suspect reversed and attempted to strike the victim again with vehicle.

The suspect fled the area after several attempts of hitting the victim with her vehicle. Fort Lauderdale Police issued a BOLO for the suspect and vehicle.

On July 10th detectives from the Rapid Offender Control Unit (ROC) observed a vehicle matching the description of the suspect vehicle in the 2700 block of Northwest 13th Street, requesting the assistance of Fort Lauderdale Patrol Units to conduct a felony traffic stop. Records check confirmed the driver and the vehicle was in fact the suspect wanted for the aggravated assault. Detectives discovered that the suspect also had active warrants for unrelated charges, issued from Fort Lauderdale Police Department.

The suspect has been identified as Sheena Gordon, B/F, 9/24/1984, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Gordon has been charged with the following;

- Aggravated Assault with Deadly Weapon

Active Warrants for the following;

- Aggravated Battery with Deadly Weapon
- Burglary
- Criminal Mischief
