**Update (2): 07.21.17**

During this investigation detectives have discovered video footage that contains an unknown black male. This male is a person of interest in the homicide of victim; Guy Eargle Jr. Detectives are attempting to identify this male.

The video footage was obtained from within the same area of where the victim's vehicle was discovered abandoned by the Broward Sheriff's Office on Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Update: 07.21.17**

Fort Lauderdale Homicide Detectives have confirmed that the victim's vehicle was stolen from the scene of the homicide. The vehicle was recovered by Broward Sheriff's Office on Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup> at approximately 9:35 P.M. in the 2600 block of Northwest 9<sup>th</sup> Court in the City of Pompano Beach.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is actively investigating the homicide of an adult male discovered on Monday, July 17<sup>th</sup> at approximately 6:15 P.M. The deceased male was discovered inside the residence located at 429 Southeast 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The victim has been identified as Guy Eargle Jr., W/M, 08/05/1948, a part time resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale and of the City of Atlanta, Georgia.

Detectives are not disclosing the manner in which the victim was murdered at this time.

This is an active investigation and circumstances surrounding the incident are still being determined.
