THREE VICTIMS OF SHOOTING

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is actively investigating a homicide that occurred on Thursday, July 20th, at approximately 6:18 P.M. The incident occurred in the 1500 block of Northwest 16th Court in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department received reports of a shooting at the location. Upon officers arrival they discovered an adult male victim in the driver seat of a vehicle, deceased, with an apparent gunshot wound. Two female victims were located outside of the vehicle with gunshot wounds and transported to Broward Health Medical Center by Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue with non-life threatening injuries.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that the three victims were traveling westbound in the listed area. Possibly two black male suspects on foot approached their vehicle and began shooting into the vehicle. The suspects were then seen fleeing the area on foot.

The victims in this incident have been identified as;

Deceased- Stanley Julien, B/M, 10/21/1998, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale Phedeline St. Felix, B/F, 03/22/1998, and a juvenile B/F, 16 years of age, both residents of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

This is an active investigation and the circumstances surrounding this incident are still being determined.
