HOMICIDE

UPDATE 9.26.17

Detectives from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department Homicide Unit and Career Criminal Unit, in conjunction with the U.S. Marshals Fugitive Task Force located Kevin Hubbard in New York.

Hubbard was taken into custody and charged with Second Degree Murder and Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon.

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is investigating the homicide of an adult male on Friday, August 11th at approximately 1:00 A.M. The incident occurred at 1125 Northwest 2nd Street in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed the victim was engaged in a verbal argument with the suspect outside the residence. The suspect then entered a vehicle and witnesses say used the vehicle to intentionally hit the victim. The suspect then left the area on foot.

The victim was transported to Broward Health Medical Center where he was pronounced deceased as a result of his injuries.

The victim has been identified as Leotis Roberson, B/M, 02/17/1983, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The suspect is identified as Kevin Hubbard, B/M, 12/14/1994, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale. The Fort Lauderdale Police Department has obtained the following arrest warrants for Hubbard:

- Second Degree Murder
- Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon

This is an active investigation and anyone with information regarding Hubbard's whereabouts is asked to dial 9-1-1.
