### **Update: 10.27.2017**

Detectives have identified the homicide suspect and taken him into custody.

The suspect has been identified as Nathaniel Petgrave, B/M, 4/07/1995, a resident of the City of Lauderdale.

Petgrave has been charged with, 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder.

### **Original: 10.23.2017**

The Fort Lauderdale Police Department is actively investigating a homicide that occurred on Saturday October 21<sup>st</sup> at approximately 12:55 A.M. The incident took place at the Midway Food Store located at 110 Northwest 11 Ave in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

Preliminary investigation has revealed the victim was in front of the business working on a disabled vehicle when the suspect walked up to him and shot him.

The victim was transported to Broward Health Medical Center where he succumbed to his injuries.

The victim has been identified as John Jackson, B/M, 1/03/1967, a resident of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

The suspect is described as a B/M, 30-35 years of age, medium build, a full beard, and wore all black clothing.
